Participation in the conference and publication of proceedings are free of charge. The Proceedings of the conference will be published in digital format. The conference proceedings will be included in the bibliographic database of the Russian Science Citation Index (RSCI) and will be accessible via the scientific electronic library eLIBRARY.RU (<https://www.elibrary.ru>)

within six months after the conference. Conference participants will receive electronic certificates to the e-mail address specified in the application.

Travel and accommodation expenses are covered by conference participants. Official invitations to the conference will be sent upon the participant's request after the application is received.

The Organizing Committee has the right to reject articles that do not meet the scope of the conference. The program will be sent to all Conference participants before the meeting.

Requirements for the articles

- length: 10000–12000 characters incl. spaces in MS Word; text formats – *.doc, *.docx (in Russian or English);
- Times New Roman, 14 pt, in tables 10–12 pt;
- Line spacing: 1.5
- Margins: 20 mm.
- Paragraph indention: 1.25.
- no links;
- no hyphenation;
- no page numbers;
- alignment: justified on the width of the page.
- For an article in Russian: title of the paper, initials and surname of author (authors); affiliation, summary and keywords – in Russian and English.
- For an article in English: title of the paper, initials and surname of author (authors); affiliation, summary and keywords – in English.

- References: after the article itself, in alphabetical order in the language of the original article under the heading "References". References are formatted according to GOST 7.05-2008.

The file name should correspond to the surname and initials of the first author without spaces (e.g., МагомедовАИ; BrownST).

Use italics and bold for **text highlighting**. Please avoid using underlining, capitalization, and spacing.

In-text references are given as follows: [ИВАНОВ 2000: 175; Thomson 2015: 16]

Article structure and rules of presentation of the main elements of materials for publication

1. Title in Russian (in TNR bold, capital letters; center alignment).
2. Information about the author(s) in Russian (italics, right alignment):
 - full surname, first name, patronymic;
 - affiliation of the author(s) (in Russian);
 - e-mail.
3. Abstract (100-150 words) in Russian;
4. Key words (5-10 words) in Russian;
5. Title in English (in TNR bold, capital letters; center alignment);
6. Information about the author(s) in English (italics, right alignment):
 - full surname, first name, patronymic;
 - affiliation of the author(s) (in English).
7. Abstract (100-150 words) in English;
8. Key words (5-10 words) in English;
9. The text of the article could be in Russian or English.
10. References (in alphabetical order, numbered, in the language of the article).
